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Ministry Description

LEAD SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER

Overview: The Lead Sunday School Teacher helps the youth ministry by developing relationships with the youth, modeling an authentic Christian faith, and teaching them the essentials of following Christ.

Description and Responsibilities:

- The teaching schedule has been overseen in your classroom and having a teacher each week has been ensured.
- Volunteers have been recruited to assist in your classroom. This includes teachers for the rotation as well as other volunteers who are willing to be present during Sunday school time.
- In consultation with the youth director, curriculum has been evaluated, chosen, and implemented in the classroom. (Curriculum options have been provided. The lead teachers have evaluated the options together and chosen accordingly).
- The youth in the class have been prayed for regularly.
- Quarterly meetings with the youth ministry staff and with other Sunday school teachers have taken place for encouragement, trouble-shooting, curriculum review, training and prayer.
- Information about any special victories, concerns or challenges being faced by the youth and his or her family have been received and, as often as reasonable, that information has been passed on to the youth ministry staff.
- Regularly strategic meetings with the youth ministry staff about any youth or parents who don't seem to be connecting have taken place.
- The teaching schedule has been coordinated with other Sunday school teachers to provide maximum consistency.
- Sunday school teachers have been regular participants in the weekly worship service at church.

Above and Beyond:

- Participation in youth ministry special events and/or weekly events has taken place as time has allowed.
- An average of 15 minutes each week has been invested developing relationships with students outside of Sunday school. (e.g. attending students events, phone calls, e-mails, Birthday, Easter, Christmas cards).

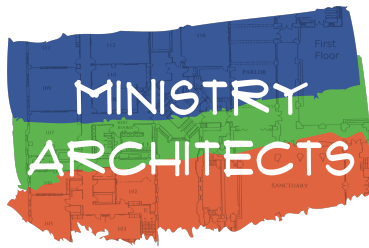
Time Commitment: 1.5 hours per week in class, plus 1 hour per week in preparation
